PREPARING FOR 62ND HOMECOMING



Brother Buford Chilcoat became pastor in July 1965, and it was a growing time for the church. In August of 1965 the Westwood Ladies Auxiliary was organized; their first project was planting shrubbery in front of the church, also in August plans were submitted for an educational building; work began on the building in Nov. 1965. The first wedding was in June of 1966; the first radio program of the church began in Jan. 1967. The church voted to begin giving 5% of income to missions in July 1967. The church voted to increase their giving to 10% in Sept. 1967.

In March of 1968 Bro. Chilcoat resigned. In Aug. 1968 Bro. Hugh Harris was pastor till Sept. 1969 when he was voted in as the president of Florida Baptist College in Lakeland.



In 1968 the church purchased a parsonage for \$9,000.00 in Inwood. The Harris and Lanier families were the only ones to live in it.

October 5, 1969, Brother Clyde Lanier accepts the position of Pastor and begins a lifetime call at Westwood Baptist Church, later changed to Westwood Missionary Baptist Church. By 1972 WMBC had five licensed and one ordained preacher. Bought their first Sunday School bus in 1972 for \$370.00, also in 1972 the adjacent property was purchased for extra Sunday School rooms (little house in parking lot). In 1973 the church voted to increase their giving to 15%.
